During the academic year 2018-19 the following activities are undertaken by IQAC:

Faculty Development Program on revised NAAC guidelines:

Internal Quality Assurance Cell, Mamasaheb Mohol College in association with IQAC Cluster Maharashtra organized FACULTY DEVELOPMENT PROGRAM ON REVISED NAAC GUIDELINES "during 18th to 21st JUNE 2018. Hon. Dr. Sanjay Kharat Principal Modern College, Pune (on 18-06-2018) guided on "Governance, Leadership and management" and Prof. Parag Shah, Modern College, Pune delivered lecture on "Curricular Aspects". On day 2 (19-06-2018) Prof. Bharat Kangude, Baburaoji Gholap College, Sangavi talked about "Infrastructure and learning resources" and Dr. Vinay Kumar Modern college, Pune guided on "Research, Innovations and Extension". Formation of IQAC according to new guidelines:

The Internal quality assurance cell was formed according to revised guidelines by approval from PDEA. Prof. Dr. A. D. Shaligram Registrar SPPU and Prof. Dr. Vijay Khare Director International center, Dean Faculty of Humanity Science and Dr. Manohar Chaskar Principal RMC Akurdi were invited on IQAC as advisor members.

3) Research paper competition:


